

Richie Arndt (born February 23, 1958 in Bielefeld) is a multi-award-winning German blues and rock musician known for his distinctive singing voice, soulful guitar playing, and musical travelogues.

Early years and musical education

Arndt began playing electric guitar at a young age. He studied music education and completed the pop course at the Hamburg University of Music and Theater, where he studied with Inga Rumpf, Peter Weihe, and Rainer Baumann, among others.

Musical development and band projects

Arndt played in various bands and projects before founding Richie Arndt & The Bluenatics in 1996. He released numerous albums, including All Kinds of Blue (1997), Voodoo (2003), and Train Stories (2009).

Musical travelogues

In 2015, Arndt released the album Mississippi – Songs Along the Road, based on his journey through the southern United States. This was followed in 2024 by Tennessee & Alabama – Songs Along the Road #2, a tribute to the music of the American South.

Solo program and current projects

With his solo program "Alone & Pure," Arndt presents acoustic interpretations of his songs, as well as selected classics from Americana and pop. He has accompanied various American artists on concerts in Europe and continues to tour with various band projects.

Awards

Arndt has received numerous awards, including the German Blues Award 2015 for "Best Contemporary Artist," 2016 for "Best Album," 2018 for "Best Voice/Male," and 2022 for "Best Guitarist."

Richie Arndt remains a defining figure in the German blues and rock scene, known for his virtuoso guitar playing and musical storytelling.
